Now, in its forty-third year, the Horsemasters Summer Camp of Horsemanship offers riders of any age and level an opportunity to advance their riding skills and improve their techniques. Our courses offer the fundamentals of riding, horse care, and stable management. Courses will focus on skills necessary for showing, eventing, and dressage. Each course is five days in length, and riders are encouraged to take advantage of the residential program (overnight housing and meals) to get maximum benefit from these intensive programs. Students may bring their own horses, which is encouraged, or use school horses provided by Horsemasters Farms.

In addition to our 5-day camps, Horsemasters will also offer day camps for Beginner through Advanced riders.

Horsemasters owners Janet and Mike Adler conduct the programs. Our riders and horses have competed successfully in hunter, jumper, dressage, and combined training competitions throughout the Northwest and Canada.

All courses are held at Horsemasters Farms, the location of the 1981 West Coast Olympic Screening Trials for the United States Three-Day Equestrian Team. Facilities include a large indoor arena and excellent outdoor amenities, including an arena, cross-country courses and 70 acres of open fields and wooded trails. In addition to summer camps, Horsemasters offers a program of daily lessons, clinics, shows and barn activities.

We invite all camp participants to compete in the Summer Series and Horse Trials we offer.

Pre-registration is necessary. Spaces in each camp are limited and classes fill early in the year.
